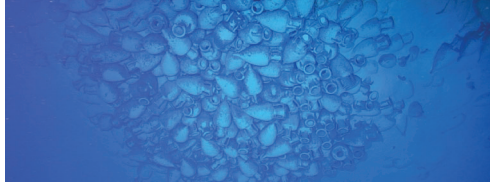

Ravello, Villa Rufolo 2-3 December 2024

Background

With the purpose of revitalizing and strengthening targeted actions in the field of maritime or underwater archaeology, thanks to a proposal submitted by Prof. David Blackman, who is a CUEBC Scientific Committee member, in October 2023 CUEBC has appointed its own expert on maritime archaeology and underwater cultural heritage in the person of Elena Flavia Castagnino Berlinghieri, Maritime Archaeologist (PhD Bristol, UK).

After due consideration during the UNITWIN meeting held in Paris UNESCO Headquarters on June the 6, 2024, CUEBC has been accredited as "observer member" to the UNESCO UNITWIN Network for underwater archaeology with the aim of collaborating with other universities, governmental organizations and competent non-governmental organizations, in particular NGOs accredited by the Meeting of States Parties of the Convention, in relation to activities within the scope of the Network.

Concept

The UCH Convention and Annex of 2001 form the cornerstone of international law, providing protection for UCH. The Round Table aims to delve into the historical *continuum* from the first CUEBC Conference organised at Villa Rufolo in Ravello (27-30 May 1993), exploring the transformative journey of UCH, fostering a deeper understanding of the development of the activities around UCH and acknowledging the importance of its principles by providing a sound basis for further negotiation of a matter of common concern for all Mediterranean countries.

In this way, by bringing together representatives from several countries, whether or not they have ratified the Convention, it will be possible to share policies, challenges, and difficulties, to identify knowledge gaps or collaboration opportunities. This meeting also aims at contributing to the ongoing effort to combat the criminal networks involved in the trafficking and at recovering cultural property illicitly exported.

Working language and simultaneous translation service

The Round Table will be conducted in English with the possibility of presentations delivered in Italian. A simultaneous translation service Italian-English will be provided.
